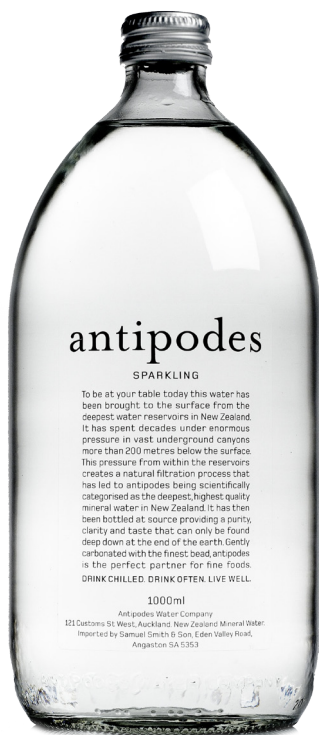

Antipodes comes from a pristine source and is a soft, low-mineral-content, artificially carbonated water with a neutral taste. The clean, modern bottle shows elegance as well as local character—it's modeled after the traditional New Zealand sherry or beer bottle. Antipodes is sold in the hospitality and restaurant industry only

Antipodes water spends fifty years under pressure in an aquifer 500 to 1,000 feet (150–305 m) below the earth, where an ignimbrite substratum acts as a natural filter. The Rotoma Hills, where rain-water that replenishes the aquifer falls, are free of industry and have a population density of not even one person per 250 acres (100 hectares).
